Education Department, Chandigarh Administration has no objection for seeking affiliation with Central Board of Secondary Education (C.B.S.E.), New Delhi to start XIth class in the stream of Medical, Non-Medical, Commerce and Humanities provisionally for the session 2019-2020 by Ajit Karam Singh International Public School, Sector-45, Chandigarh, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

- i) The area of the site shall conform to the minimum area prescribed by CBSE;
- ii) There shall be no relaxation of FAR;
- iii) The number of students shall be regulated in accordance with the covered area available with the school and no overcrowding shall be allowed;
- iv) The admission in 11th class will not be made until the affiliation is granted by the CBSE;
- v) The School will make compliance of the observations already conveyed in the order of extension in provisional recognition;
- vi) School will get the status of land upgraded from Estate Office, UT, Chandigarh as required;
- vii) Land will be used for the purpose strictly for the purpose it was originally allotted;
- viii) Provision of RTE Act and the guidelines issued by the U.T, Administration/CBSE from time to time will be complied with by the school authority in letter and spirit;
- x) The labs must be revamped in the school for science stream in class XI and XII.
- xi) School management should seek permission for getting upgradation of school upto secondary level from the Estate Office, UT, Chandigarh
- xii) Matter can be reviewed by the Department in case of violation of terms and conditions:

ORDER

Extension of recognition is granted to Ajit Karam Singh International School, Sector-45A, Chandigarh upto secondary level from 1.4.2018 to 31.3.2023 under Article 235 read with 241-A of Punjab Education Code subject to the condition that the school should ensure that all the conditions as given below are complied within six months before the expiry of the extended period of recognition failing which further recognition would not be considered:-

1. Provisions of RTE Act and other instructions issued by the Education Department related to admission of students under EWS category and disadvantages groups be followed in letter and spirit (wherever applicable);
2. School will follow the provision of Rules of Recognition of Punjab Education Code;
3. School will follow land allotment conditions and other notifications/ orders/ instructions issued by the Chandigarh Administration from time to time;
4. Managing Committee will be got approved from the Department.
5. Salary to the staff be paid as per the CBSE Affiliation Bye Laws;
6. Reserve Fund be pledged as made applicable from time to time;
7. No particular book shop be prescribed for purchase of book/uniform etc. by the school;
8. Instructions/guidelines issued by CBSE relating to books/uniforms are to be followed;
9. Fire Safety norms be followed meticulously and there should be no laxity in this regard on the part of school;
10. Fee should be charged from the students as per CBSE Affiliation By Laws and receipt be issued to the students against the money charged from them;
11. Staff engaged should be fully qualified and untrained teachers should be replaced with trained ones;
12. Recognition is liable to withdraw if the management or the staff of the school take part in agitation directed against the authority of Government, or disseminate opinions tending to excite feelings of disloyalty or disaffection against Government or of enmity and hatred between different classes or if the pupils are permitted to attend political meetings or to engage in any form of political meetings or to engage in any form of political or communal agitation;
13. Government reserves the right, to grant, refuse or withdraw recognition at its entire discretion;.....
14. School will recruit teachers as per NCTE notification dated 12.11.2014 regarding minimum qualification of teachers including the qualifications prescribed for teachers including the qualifications prescribed for teachers at pre primary level as per letter dated 2.4.2018;
15. Building completion certificate may be submitted by the school;
16. Proper maintenance of service books, accounts and other school records may be ensured by the school authority.
